

# Bus Directions to Pinasca from Caselle

- Take the blue **Sadem** bus line from just out front doors of the airport terminal to **Porta Nuova** train station in downtown Torino.
- Cost from the airport is approximately €5,50 one-way. It takes about an hour and you can purchase your ticket close to the bus departure point. .50 more if purchased on the bus. Do have small bills or change, as it is difficult for the drivers to make change.
- The buses leave frequently and a bit longer between departures during holidays.
- At Porta Nuova, the bus should stop in front of **Bar Cervino**. Walk to the corner that will be Corso Vittorio Emmanuelle and Corso Sacchi.
- You take a **Sapav** bus that should say Pinerolo/ Pinasca/Perosa Argentina on the front of the bus, if you are going to Pinasca.
- Purchase your ticket for Pinasca from Café Nero or the one next door to it. Catch the **Sapav** bus in front of this bar. (Cost about 3,00 € one way) [www.sapav.it](http://www.sapav.it)
- You want to get off at **Pinasca Centro or Chiesa** (church)



Generally if you say to the driver, **Pinasca Centro (pronounced Pee-nas-ka Chin-tro)**, they will try to let you know when you are getting close, as it is a request stop. Make sure there is a church (chiesa pronounced kee ay za) in front of you as they sometimes let you off a bit early.

I recommend sitting as close up front so you can see and have the driver help you if necessary. As you are approaching, you should see a sign for Pinasca, a Brico building center on the left. A little further you will see the steeple of the church coming up and the bus stops just a few houses up before the parking lot by the church.

Bar **Claudio Monica** is across the street and they are use to our guests waiting for us to pick them up there and can be very helpful.
